Pet Club Announce MicroChip Initiative

The Sun City Anthem Pet Club would like to advise all pet owners that in addition to protecting our pets with a microchip, it is extremely important to register the chip. The only information on the chip is a number that should also be on the yellow tag given to owners when they have their pet microchipped. All animals rescued are either microchipped before they leave the shelter, or have the information of the previous owner associated with the microchip. The new owner must fill out the paper work they received when they acquired their pet and mail it. The registration can also be done online and information needs to be updated when address or phone number changes.

In the past few weeks, several pets have been found not wearing collars or tags but they were microchipped. While the animals were microchipped, there was no registration information. Good neighbors made sure they were returned home. Our companion animals are not street smart and could easily get run over by a car. Especially the smaller animals are in danger of predators, not to mention it is a violation of the leash law. Sunridge Animal Hospital at 10850 S Eastern in Henderson is willing to assist those who find an animal to check for a microchip. Most of the animals we find are local and are not wearing a collar or tags. All your companion animals should be fitted with a collar that should not be removed except to bathe your pet. In addition to the microchip, they should wear an ID tag that lists their name, your name, address phone number and cell number. The cell number is very important if an animal is lost while you are traveling unless you forward your home phone to your cell.

Anthem residents should be sure to register their pets with the Patrol Office. You should have a picture of your pet and stop by the Patrol Office next to the Bocce Courts to register your pet. There are two websites that allow you to register your pets no matter who inserted the microchip. Visit www.homeagain.com or www.petlink.net to register your pet's information. If you see an animal running loose, it's a good idea to keep a leash in your car. Most dogs will come to a leash where they will run if chased. At the very least your pet should know the "sit" and "stay" command so they are easier to catch. Try this with an animal running loose before you try and chase them. Another good reason to join the pet club is that we get to know you and your pet and can help to get your pet home quickly and safely. 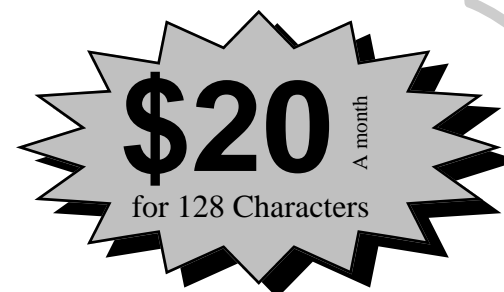
